




Day 1 Arrive in Prague, Czech Republic

25 December 2013

Welcome to Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic. The city straddles in the Vltava River with domes, cupolas, spires and pinnacles highlighting its skyline. Tonight, a Christmas dinner awaits you. (D)

Day 2 Prague

26 December 2013

Prague is a 1,000-year-old city preserved in time. Day 4 Nuremberg
